IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT CHECK-IN DAY, ROOMMATES, AND MICROWAVES

Dear Parents and Students:

Here is some last-minute information to help you prepare for check-in day. Please note the following:

CHECK-IN

On check-in day (June 4, 2023), please go to the check-in area (lobby) in Collette Dorm. There you will receive your key and other important information. The parent information page has a map of campus, and we will have signs posted around campus to help direct you to the dorm and parent meeting. Please make every effort to arrive no earlier than 11:00 AM for all students. If you must arrive earlier or much later, please let us know ahead of time.

Please note that all of the students will be living on the 2nd (girls) and 3rd (boys) floors of the dorm and there is no elevator.

Please have any prescription or over the counter medicine ready to be inventoried and turned in at check-in.

Parents, please also plan on attending the Parent Meeting at 2:30 PM in the Holbrook Student Union (Old Ranch outside of the cafeteria). At the parent meeting we will introduce you to the faculty and staff, go over some of the more important aspects of the Program, and have a Q & A session as needed.

ROOMMATES

- In order to ease move-in day (somewhat) and to help ensure that there is as little duplication as possible in items brought, we will

 assignments in place by Thursday June 1st.
- o If you have a specific roommate request that you haven't let us know about, please tell us as soon as possible, and know that we need both students involved to express the same desire.

REFRIGERATORS / MICROWAVES

- There should be enough space in the room for every student to have his or her own refrigerator if they care to; however, we still
 encourage you to get in touch with each other if you have any interest in sharing a refrigerator.
- Microwaves and other cooking elements are not allowed in the rooms in Collette Hall. Please be aware that students will have access to a GPGC microwave in the common areas of the dorm until 9 PM.

TABLETS / CELL PHONES / OTHER INTERNET DEVICES

- Parents should know that freely accessible Wi-Fi is becoming more and more prevalent across campus. If you provide your student
 with a device that can access the internet, please understand that we will not be able to monitor or control what your student is
 accessing with their personal devices.
- o We are strongly considering the regulation of devices that can access the internet as we regulate cell phones now. Please be ready for the possibility that you will be required to turn in such devices as we determine is appropriate.
